



IN SIROHI Adarsh Foundation adopts Anganwadis

Adarsh Foundation (ACF) has adopted 12 anganwadis in Sirohi, Rajasthan, with an aim to improve the quality of early childhood education. The flagship project of developing model anganwadis in Sirohi, which can later be replicated in the rest of the state, was inaugurated in Khambal village and Goyali village, in the presence of Ms. Anita Bhadel, State Women and Child Development Minister, Rajasthan and Shri Mukesh Modi, Founder and Mentor, Adarsh Credit Co-operative Society Ltd.



ACF IS FOCUSING ON THREE KEY AREAS

1 Infrastructure: ACF has done repairs, painting and equipped the anganwadis to make it a conducive environment for children. These are some of the few aanganwadis in the state which use Solar Energy for all its electricity requirements. It's a small but definite effort in reducing our carbon footprint and our commitment to sustainable development. Children are also provided with clean filtered water to ensure good health.

2 Improve quality of learning: ACF introduces play-based learning for children. Each anganwadi has a local female support teacher (Adarsh shikshika), who is trained in play-based teaching. Adarsh Foundation also distributed bags to children and launched two books published by them containing poems and stories for children in their anganwadis.

3 Nutrition: To ensure that children have healthy growth and to alleviate malnutrition, ACF provides nutrition supplements to children in addition to mid-day meals that the anganwadis provide.

With a goal to educate children of Baiga tribe, with special focus on girl children and children with special needs, residing in the Kabirdham district of Chhattisgarh, ACF is supporting the Samerth Bal Mitra Kendra which works towards providing education, nutrition, health care.

ACF is partnering with various leading organisations to improve quality of education in India. ACF is supporting two Balghars, to improve the quality of early childhood education in the construction site of Juhapura slums in Ahmedabad, through Saath Charitable Trust, Ahmedabad. ACF is providing education through Project-based learning for tribal children of Class 6 to 9 in Seoni, Madhya Pradesh, in partnership with Agrini Samaj Kalyan Samiti.

Adarsh Foundation supports inclusive education

Taking the concept of inclusive education to villages, Adarsh Foundation with support from Blind People's Association, inaugurated a centre for special education at the Smt SS Rathode School, Mahudi, Gandhi Nagar.

A total of 80 children have been identified across age groups. For those children who cannot come to the centre, home-based education is being provided.



IN OTHER ACTIVITIES

Developing skill for youth

Adarsh Foundation has signed an MoU with SHRUSHTI Seva Samiti, Udaipur to train 300 youth in Sirohi, Rajasthan. The youth will be given training in mobile repairing and electrical wiring with an aim to generate self-employment.
